Welcome to the July issue of the Hallsville Quarter Phase 3 development newsletter, looking at the latest progress achieved and upcoming milestones.

Progress to date – Completed

- The garage demolition is completed.
- The car park entrance and exit are relocated on to Silvertown way.
- Clarkson & Wouldham Road closed and will now become part of the construction works.
- Temporary site office are erected.
- Appropriate measures are implemented regarding Covid 19 in line with CLC and PHE recommendations.

Forthcoming milestones – Task starting in July

We apologies in advance as the following works will be noisy and with vibration effect.

- Sheet piling works for the temporary car park ramp will start in July.
- Signage diversion for the pedestrians will be implemented temporarily. There is no impact on pedestrians.
- Piling works and the excavation of the new basement will start in July.
- Erect new hoarding & refresh existing hoarding.
- The first crane will be erected circa end of July to early August close to Silvertown way

Environmental:

Bouygues UK works in partnership with Community Wood Recycling (www.communitywoodrecycling.org.uk) The site has signed up to use waste management, collecting waste timber and plywood in any condition, and to recycle 100% meaning zero goes to landfill.

Considerate Construction Scheme (CCS):

The site has signed up for the Considerate Construction Site (CCS) as part of the ongoing commitment to the Health & Safety of the community and workforce.

Community Social & Responsibility (CSR):

Social Value Team had a meeting with London Borough of Newham workplace one stop shop where Newham residents can received employment advice. We discuss employment opportunities for local people, work experience including school and Universities site visits.
