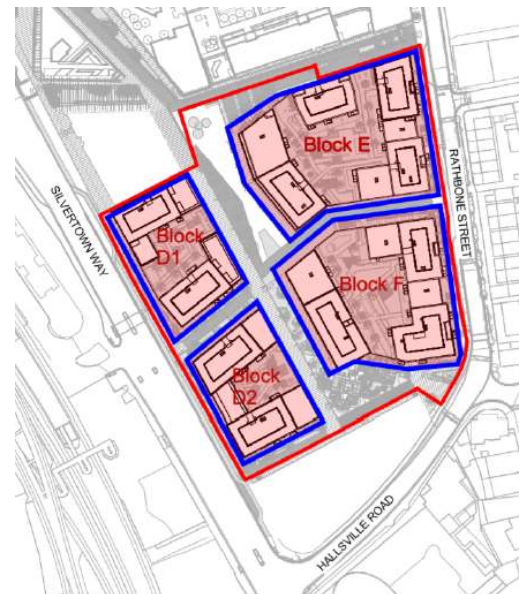
Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to the October 2020 issue of the Hallsville Quarter Phase 3 development newsletter, looking at the latest progress achieved and upcoming milestones.

Works progress

- We have completed the main excavation and concrete pile foundations works for this first phase of the works.
- We have started the foundations (pile caps and ground beams) on basement level Block F.
- The foundation works are completed on Block D2 (Silvertown Way). We have now started the walls and columns at ground floor level of this block.
- The 2nd and 3rd tower cranes will be installed in October for the Block F along Hallsville Way.
- The below ground services installation connecting each new block of the HQ3 will also start in October 2020.
