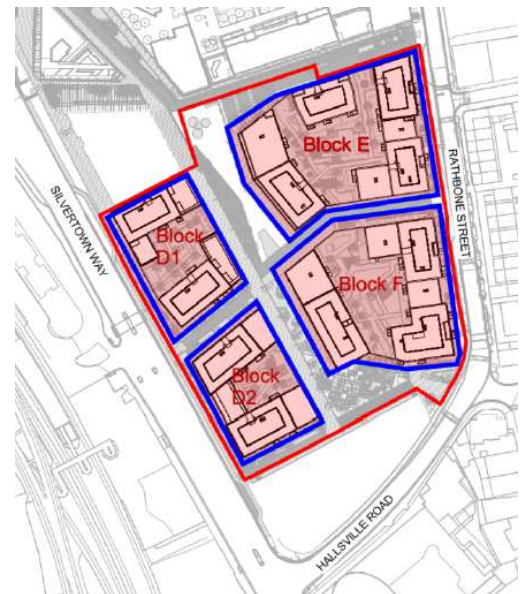
Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to the November 2020 issue of the Hallsville Quarter Phase 3 development newsletter, looking at the latest progress achieved and upcoming milestones.

Works progress

- Two additional Tower Cranes have been installed and are now fully operational for Block F.
- Blocks E and F: Foundations (piles caps and ground beams) are progressing.
- Block D2 on Silvertown Way: ground floor: slab, columns and walls have been completed.
- Block D2 we will progress with the first-floor slab and walls in November 2020.
- The hoarding branding was installed and includes photographs and artwork from the local community in collaboration with Newham Council.
