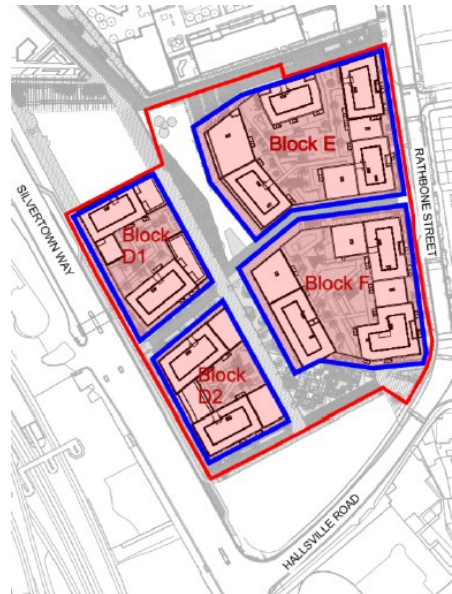
Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to the January 2021 issue of the Hallsville Quarter Phase 3 development newsletter, looking at the latest progress achieved and upcoming milestones.

## Works progress

- All 5 tower cranes are installed.
- The Reinforced Concrete structure of Block 2 reached level 2 at the end of December 2020 and will continue its progress upward.
- We are progressing on the basement of the blocks E&F. The basement slab of Block F is complete and we will start the ground floor slab and some of the vertical structure on Block F in January 2021.
- We will progress the foundation and basement works on Block E in January 2021.
- Hoardings along Rathbone Street will be moved to allow drainage installation of block E & E.

The team will continue to work with Newham Workplace on job opportunities, work experience placements, volunteering and events in the local community in the coming year.
