
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Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to the June 2021 issue of the Hallsville Quarter Phase 3 development newsletter, which reviews the latest progress achieved on site and the upcoming milestones.

Works progress

- Our structural concrete works reached Level 5 on Block D2 and progress continues as expected.
- Work has now started on the first floor of Block F which continues the construction of the maisonettes along Rathbone street
- On the Block E the basement level car park will be completed shortly. In parallel we have already started the elevation of the Ground Floor which is where you can see the numerous columns.
- The external drainage works are progressing on the South section of D2, closing each area at a time.



Events

The team worked with Newham Council to donate and install three wooden planters in Russell Road and Burrard Road, these are now ready for the residents to start their growing projects. The focus is to plant a combination of herbs, vegetables and flowers.

We have organised two workshops Introduction to HQ3 Project for the University of East London (UEL) in early June and H&S training Fire Marshal for Department of Welfare & Pension (DWP) clients at the end of June.
