Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to the July 2021 issue of the Hallsville Quarter Phase 3 development newsletter, which reviews the latest progress achieved on site and upcoming milestones.

## Works progress

- Our structural concrete works reached Level 6 on Block D2 and progress continues as expected.
- Works are progressing well on the first floor of Block F and on the construction of the maisonettes along Rathbone street
- On the Block E the basement level car park is completed. In parallel we are progressing on the Ground and first floors.
- Drainage connection works will take place on the South-East of the site, on Hallsville Road, until mid-July 2021. Temporary traffic management agreed with Newham Highways will be in place to regulate local traffic.



## Events

On 10<sup>th</sup> June we hosted the University of East London (UEL) and presented the project to them via remote video presentation.

The team has volunteered with Carpenters Primary School, discussion with landmarks.
