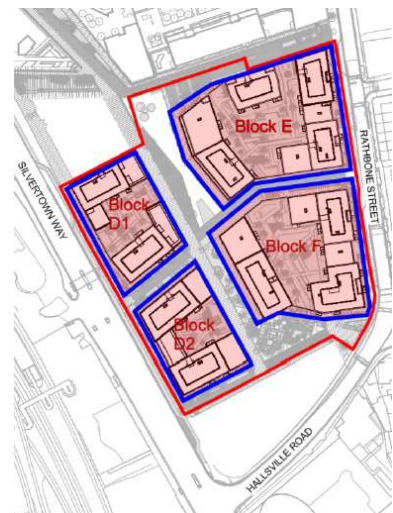

Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to the August 2021 issue of the Hallsville Quarter Phase 3 development newsletter, which reviews the latest progress achieved on site and upcoming milestones.

Works progress

- Our structural concrete works reached Level 8 on Block D2 and progress continues as expected.
- Structure Works are progressing on the first and second floors of Block F with both floors of duplexes taking shape on Rathbone street.
- The first floor slab of Block E is progressing rapidly on the western section and the double-height walls on the eastern section of the building have been concreted.
- The upgrading works within the Phase 1 energy centre have begun and continue to progress as planned for the new CHP boiler installation.
- Power connection to the main project feed works are developing along Silvertown Way and underneath A13.

On the 8th July members of the Linkcity team volunteered at Brampton Manor Academy, Newham for the "Annual Boss Day". Throughout the day, Linkcity hosted classroom workshops with Year 9 and 10 students to help prepare them for further education and the world of work.
