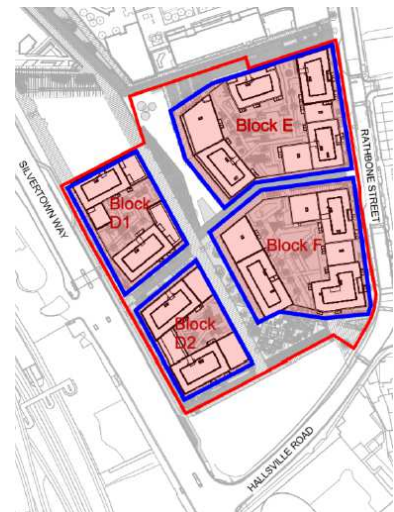

Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to the September 2021 issue of the Hallsville Quarter Phase 3 development newsletter, which reviews the latest progress achieved on site and upcoming milestones.

Works progress

- Our structural concrete works reached Level 10 on Block D2 and progress continues as expected. We can now see the two distinctive cores splitting from level 8.
- Structure Works are progressing on the second floor of Block F to complete the Podium slab, where the two residential blocks are starting.
- We are closing the Block E podium slab at first floor and we are also starting the concrete frame on the Western core E3.
- The new CHP boiler installation, part of the HQ1 energy center upgrading works, is progressing as planned.



Events

This month we have two University of London students joining our team at HQ3 for 13 weeks paid work placement. This is to give them experience and knowledge around working on a live construction site.

We also have another two students who have been taken on for a placement year as part of their university training. They will be working with the civils team on site

These recruitments are in line with our London Borough of Newham planning targets.
