Building D2

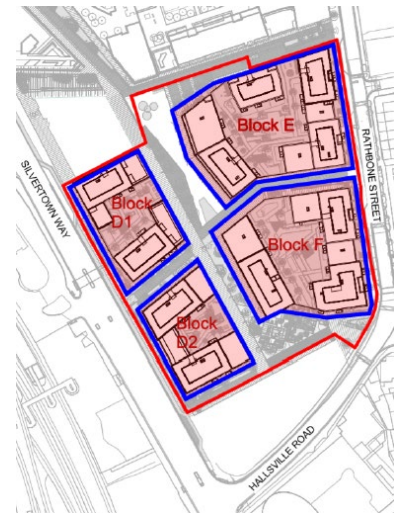
Benchmark flat decoration completed as well as the flooring installation.
