Building D2

- Fit out sequence in flats almost completed and continues in communal areas;
- Fit out to the Entrance & Amenity spaces works are ongoing;
- Installation of the facades cladding works are ongoing;
- Scaffolding strike started

- Fit-out sequence in flats & communal continues;
- Scaffold strike started in Block E and ongoing in Block E
- Brickwork completed on Block F and Block E Core 3 (Podium elevation) and up to level 7 on Block E, Core 1 (Podium elevation);
- Insulation works to the roof are progressing.
